- **Our Classes:** 20 contact hours (45 min each) are held each morning and include placement test & induction on the first day. Students have two different teachers every day - the first morning period follows a textbook lesson structure, while the second period has a communicative focus and once a week, we also have a random Teacher Swap lesson. aterials specially designed to engage today’s teens and we have teachers swap their second period classes once a week to add more variety of teaching styles and vocal comprehension. All students are tested weekly and receive a CEF graded Academic Certificate with skills report upon course completion.

- **Our Homestay Accommodation:** We have been working with most of our hosts for many years; all homes have been inspected and our hosts interviewed, inducted, and are police vetted.

- **Our Weekend, Afternoon & Evening Activities:** Students receive two to three off campus afternoon excursions (cultural, historical & active/sporting) every week. All students have a weekly social event every Saturday. Residential students have extra evening activities (Cinema, Bowling, Soccer, Races).



See sample schedule on the next page. On Daytrip Excursions we visit to Dublin every second week, Cork City plus Kinsale, Kilkenny, Tipperary and Wexford. Our extra-curricular



weekday activities include a well-balanced mix of interesting cultural experiences, combined with exciting active pursuits a generous mix of cultural destinations, social evening events, afternoon adventure activities and on-campus sports, games and contests (i.e., Drama Challenge Show where drama groups compete against other classes for prizes.). Our most popular day is Club Day, where students choose their own activities. This means, students choose from a number of clubs: Surfing, Splashworld Swimming, Bowling, Mini Golf, and Splashcoaster & Pedal Boats.

Apologies we do not have facilities to accommodate deadly allergies or students with serious behavioural/mental health conditions. • Students may walk up to 35 minutes to/from the school. Bus/car transport available beyond. • Residential Students share student apartments with private rooms and en-suite toilet.
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Residential weekly activities include 2 daytrips, 2/3 off-campus activities plus 1-2 evening social events. • Homestay weekly activities include 2 daytrips, 2/3 off-campus activities plus 1-2 evening social events.
